- The teams will be staying at the Motel 6 and the Howard Johnson Inn.
- The games will be played at Al Alford Field, Gabe Nesbitt Field at Craig Ranch, and possibly McKinney Boyd HS.
- Water and PowerAde will be provided to the players on each team during the games. Players may carry in their own water, etc as long as it can be stored in the dugouts. If your player has special needs, please let us know well before his first game.
- **Admission** is by ticket or passes only. No one will be admitted unless they have a single game ticket or series pass. Tickets are not sold for the day. The tickets are sold for the game, or session.

EXAMPLE: If you show up and buy a ticket for the first game, and you stay at the Stadium, then you will not have to have another ticket. If you buy a single game ticket, leave the Stadium and return during a different game, you will need to buy a ticket for the next game.

- Full Concessions will be available during all games. **No coolers, or outside food and drink will be allowed in the stadium.**
- Handicap seating and parking are available.
- No lawn chairs allowed. Please feel free to bring stadium seats.
- The Stadiums are Tobacco free complexes and **no pets are allowed.**
- Seating at AL Alford stadium is approximately 1/3 covered and 2/3 open.

Umbrellas are allowed and useful in the Texas Sun. Please do not block anyone's view. All seating at the other venues are not covered.

- **Players Welcome Dinner.** The players and coaches will be welcomed to McKinney, Texas and AL Alford Field on Tuesday August 4<sup>th</sup>. We will serve the players and coaches a Texas barbecue meal and feature a baseball skills challenge for the players from each team.

Barbecue, as well as other food and drink will also be for sale to the parents and fans at this event. Admission is free for this event. It will be a fun evening at the Ballpark.

Players will wear their team caps, t-shirts and shorts. Uniforms are not required for this evening of fun.

### **Souvenirs / Tickets**

- We will be selling souvenir caps, t-shirts, and programs throughout the tournament. The programs may not be available until the 2nd day of the tournament.

- We will be selling discounted series passes for \$20.00 (regular price \$25.00) the night of the Players Welcome Dinner. **They will only be discounted on Tuesday, August 4**
